- Ensure the safety and well-being of MSMS students
- Transport students to activities and medical appointments
- Participate in staff duty rotation as assigned and carry out assigned duties

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- Associate's degree (Bachelor's degree preferred) or Related Work Experience
- A valid Mississippi Class B Commercial Driver's License with a P & S endorsement is required. This license can be acquired after employment begins
- Successful completion of pre-employment drug and alcohol test
- Certification in First Aid and CPR for all age groups transported
- Clear criminal background check and child abuse registry check
