## **ANNOUNCEMENT OF VACANCY**

### **COMPUTER SCIENCE TEACHER**

The Mississippi School for Mathematics and Science is accepting applications for an adjunct faculty position in Computer Science for the Fall 2026 semester. The successful candidate will be qualified to teach dual credit courses through Mississippi State University. Teaching assignments will include two sections of Introduction to Programming and one section of 3D Printing. All sections involve face-to-face instruction. If student interest is high enough, we will open sections for additional courses in the Spring 2027 semester. We will also seek a full-time Computer Science teacher with a contract that begins in the Fall 2027 semester.

MSMS is a public, residential high school for academically gifted and talented eleventh and twelfth grade students located on the campus of the Mississippi University for Women in Columbus, Mississippi. The mission is “to enhance the future of Mississippi by providing innovative learning experiences in a residential environment to meet individual needs of gifted and talented students and by providing quality educational leadership and aggressive outreach programs.” All faculty, staff, and students have the responsibility to assist with accomplishing the mission. We are committed to making our Computer Science program grow.

### **MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS**

1. Master’s Degree or above in related area, or credentials that will qualify the application to teach Computer Science courses at MSU.
2. Teaching experience.

### **TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT**

1. MSMS will pay \$3000 for each section taught.
2. The position is contracted for 90 days.
3. Reporting date will be August 3, 2025.

Applications, which will consist of a cover letter, a CV, a statement of teaching philosophy, and three recommendation letters, will be accepted until the position is filled.
